How to get here.

Directions by car

From the west

- ◆ Take route 2 east to Exit 59 (Arlington Center Belmont Center).
- ◆ Turn right at end of the ramp onto Route 60.
- ◆ At the first light, take a left onto Brighton St.
- ◆ Go straight on Brighton St. through one light and across the railroad tracks. (Brighton St. becomes Blanchard Rd. when you cross into Cambridge.)
- ◆ We are on the left-hand side, across from the True Value hardware store.

From Fresh Pond rotary

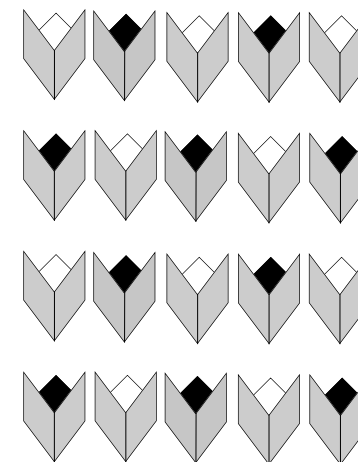
- ◆ Enter the rotary and take exit onto Concord Avenue. It's the road just after the building with TD Bank and Sleepy's.
- ◆ At the third set of lights on Concord, take a right onto Blanchard Road. Be careful not to take right onto Griswold St. which is just before the light.
- ◆ Our shop is about 1/4 mile down on the right, across from the True Value hardware store.

Directions by public transportation

- ◆ Take the red line train to Harvard Square.
- ◆ The bus leaves from underground at the Harvard Square T stop. Take the #78 bus to our shop.
- ◆ It's about a 10 minute ride to the shop. After the bus leaves Harvard Square, it goes straight on Concord Avenue. It goes through a rotary and continues on Concord. About a mile after the rotary, the bus will take a right. That's Blanchard Road.
- ◆ We are about a 1/4 of a mile down the road, on the right hand side, directly across the street from the True Value hardware store.

✂ Japanese Sashiko +

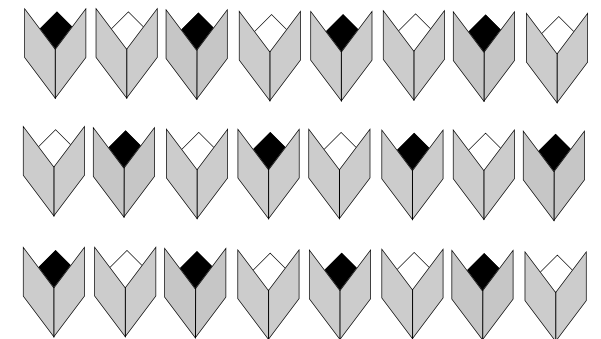
